# Cable TV:

# Telephone:

# **Transportation**

New Admission Transportation: There is no transportation charge for (local) new admissions to Dove Healthcare – Bloomer.

Appointments: We will schedule transportation with the provider of your choice or transportation can be provided by family. Contact the health unit coordinator (HUC) for assistance.

#### Pharmacy

Costs for pharmacy supplies and medications are available through Health Direct at 715-832-3780 or the pharmacy of the resident's choice. Health Direct will send bills to residents.

#### Podiatry, Audiology, & Dental Services

Podiatry, dental and audiology services are provided by the resident's choice of provider. Consult with provider for fee information.

# Daily or Sunday Papers:

Residents may order newspapers individually and the newspapers will be delivered to individual rooms. Billing arrangements are made directly with the newspaper company.

#### Dry Cleaning:

Each individual provider determines cost for dry cleaning.
